**VP-1 POPS Reunion 2007**  
**"Branson Bash"**

The next biennial VP-1 POPS Reunion will be October 4 to 8, 2007 at the Grand Plaza Hotel in Branson, Missouri. Branson's stages offer more than 100 shows to the seven million visitors who converge on this beautiful Ozark Mountain town of 6,000 residents. Branson boasts eight 18-hole golf courses, three outlet malls featuring over 200 outlet stores, and more than 400 restaurants. Our October 4 - 8 dates will be very nice with cool temperatures, changing tree colors, and not having the summer family tourist traffic.

The Grand Plaza Hotel is very nice and centrally located to the entertainment section of Branson (which is practically all of Branson). We will have a large hospitality room in the Ridgeview Room. The hotel has 200 rooms and was newly remodeled in April 2005.

Presently we have 70 Standard Rooms and 5 mini-suites reserved, however more are available if we get our reservations in early. The rooms are very nice, choices of a Standard Room (king bed or two queen beds), or mini-suites. There is a free deluxe hot continental breakfast which includes waffles and sausage plus other breakfast items. There is a full service restaurant in the hotel that is proud of their prime rib. There is an indoor pool, fitness room, game room and a very nice lounge/bar on the ninth floor which is large enough to handle a medium sized group...a good place for initially meeting squadron mates. The hotel offers lots of free convenient parking.

Branson is conveniently located in Southwest Missouri, within a day's drive of one third of the country's population. Branson lies 11 miles north of the Arkansas state line and 39 miles south of Springfield, MO. Traffic from the north to Branson and other points west can take Missouri Highway 465, also known as the Ozark Mountain Highroad, a new four-lane route connecting to Missouri Highway 76 west of the Branson city limits. Some representative mileages to Branson are:

Phoenix 1321, Los Angeles 1652, Denver 831, Orlando 1071, Atlanta 632, Chicago 546, Wichita 303, Baltimore 1068, Boston 1414, St Louis 264, Albuquerque 860, Cleveland 811, Tulsa 219, Portland 1996, Memphis 253, Dallas 415, Seattle 2080, Madison 611.

By air, the Springfield-Branson National Airport (SGF) is 43 miles from Branson and serves all of Southwest Missouri with 66 daily flights connecting to eight international airports via six airlines. There are direct flights to/from Atlanta, Chicago, Cincinnati, Dallas/Ft Worth, Denver, Detroit, Las Vegas, Memphis, Minneapolis, Orlando and St Louis. The airport offers rental car options.
